ORDINANCE NO. 2021-10

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 925.04(b)(2)(C) and (D),
SECTION 929.21(e)(1) and (2), AND SECTION 933.01(b)(3) and (4) OF
THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WAUSEON**

WHEREAS, the Wauseon Codified Ordinances set forth a tap fee for sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and water services in Section 925.04(b)(2)(C) and (D), Section 929.21(e)(1) and (2), and Section 933.01(b)(3) and (4). respectively; and

WHEREAS, Council desires that Section 925.04(b)(2)(C) and (D), Section 929.21(e)(1) and (2), and Section 933.01(b)(3) and (4) of the Codified Ordinances be amended to allow the Director of Public Service to determine the proper tap fee based on current costs each;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1.

That Section 925.04(b)(2)(C) and (D) be amended to state as follows:

(C) For all taps of six inches or under, an additional fee based on a rate which shall be determined by the Director of Public Service each December 1st for the following year.

(D) For all taps over six inches, a fee in the amount set forth in Section 925.04(b)(2)(C) and an additional fee which shall include the costs of all labor and materials for installing the tap.

Section 2.

That Section 929.21(e)(1) and (2) be amended to state as follows:

(e) The costs for a tap to a storm sewer shall be as follows:

(1) a tap fee based on a rate to be determined by the Director of Public Service each December 1st for the following year.

(2) \$35 for the inspection fee.

The tap fee will be waived in those limited situations in which: the home is built before 2009, and the sanitary and storm sewer lines are tied together and the tap will result in a complete separation of the two lines.


Section 3.


That Section 933.01(b)(3) and (4) be amended to state as follows:

(3) For all taps of one inch or under, an additional fee based on a rate which shall be determined by the Director of Public Service each December 1st for the following year.

(4) For all taps over six inches, a fee in the amount set forth in Section 933.01(b)(3) and an additional fee which shall include the costs of all labor and materials for installing the tap.
