## RESOLUTION 2021-19

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MET LIFE TO PROVIDE LIFE INSURANCE AND VOLUNTARY DENTAL AND VISION INSURANCE FOR FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City currently offers life insurance and voluntary dental and vision insurance to all full-time employees; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to continue to offer life insurance and voluntary dental and vision insurance; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires that the City enter into an agreement with Met Life pursuant to the proposal on file in the office of the Clerk of Council to provide such coverage for 2022; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City, and in order that that the insurance be available January 1, 2022;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Wauseon as follows:

Section 1.

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Met Life for the provision of life insurance and voluntary dental and vision insurance for all full-time employees for 2022 pursuant to the proposal on file in the office of the Clerk of Council.


Section 2.

The Mayor is further authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intention of Council pursuant to the Resolution.

Section 3.

That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of health, safety, and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.


