RESOLUTION 2021-2

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT FOR A POSTAGE METER WITH INTELLIGENT MAILING SOLUTIONS, INC.; AND DECLARNG AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Wauseon utilizes a postage meter for mailing letters and other documents; and

WHEREAS, the current postage meter no longer functions properly and is in need of replacing; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a lease agreement (“Agreement”) with Intelligent Mailing Solutions, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the execution of the Agreement is appropriate and necessary to the function and operations of the City; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Agreement is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City because the City is in need of a fully operational and fully functioning postage meter to mail letters and other documents;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1

The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of Council.

Section 2


The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary therefore.


Section 3.

That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of health, safety, and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage


