RESOLUTION 2021-25

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ESTABLISH A NEW FUND FOR THE DEPOSITING AND ADMINISTRATION OF FUNDS FROM CERTAIN FIRE AND EMS LEVIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.09 a special fund may automatically be created for levies put forth for Fire and EMS services

WHEREAS, the City of Wauseon desires to establish a new fund, to be known as the "Fire/EMS Fund" for the purposes of receipts and dispursements of funds generated by Township and County Levies starting 1/1/2022.

WHEREAS, this Resolution should be declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and public welfare of the City because it is necessary that the fire and EMS levy funds received in 2022 be deposited into separarely dentifired funds for proper tracking and administration by the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Wauseon, Fulton County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1.

That the Director of Finance is hereby authorized to create the following new fund known as "Fire/EMS Fund" (Fund #230).

Section 2.

That all funds received from the Fire and EMS levies shall be deposited and all expenses related to the Fire /EMS department shall be withdrawn from this fund commencing January 1, 2022.

Section 3.

That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of health, safety, and public welfare of the citizens of the City of Wauseon, and shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
